

## 2020 LIVING WORD CHURCH REACH SCHOLARSHIP

In 2018, God gave a mandate to Pastor Byron P. Franklin, Sr. that in 2019 and beyond, the focus of Living Word Church would be REACH. This directive has three aspects, which include REACH UP (developing our relationship with God), REACH IN (discovering our unique God-given design and gifts), and REACH OUT (using our gifts to REACH outside of the church walls to bring out positive change and win our community and our world to Christ. As a part of this effort, we are introducing the REACH scholarship, a \$500 scholarship that will be rewarded to one (1) high school senior living in either Sumter, Marengo or Greene County.

PLEASE NOTE: Preference will be given to current and former qualifying Living Word Church members; however, should no applications be received from LWC seniors, the scholarship will be awarded to any *qualifying* high school senior.

## **Scholarship Requirements:**

- Student should be from Sumter, Marengo or Greene County
- At least a 3.0 GPA
- Award is \$500 to one high school senior
- Must be accepted to any accredited community college or 4-yr institution.

Students must submit a 500-word typed essay on the subject: *In light of the* current climate in the U.S. regarding race relations, what would be your message to this current generation of high school and college students on how to effectively bring about change and reconciliation in the Black Belt Region?
